<u>Purpose/Scope</u>: The Infantry Marksmanship Training (IMT) Program is designed to improve the marksmanship ability of attendees, develop advanced marksmanship instructors, and provide a template for marksmanship instruction moving forward. This 10-Day program provides a baseline level of knowledge to maximize the effectiveness of the shooter's weapon and equipment, build efficiency into movement and shooting tasks, all while removing any barriers to information transfer. IMT provides a methodology to allow attendees to train, maintain, and develop skills outside of the formal course.

2. Course Prerequisites.

- a. Rank LCpl MSgt, MOS 03xx; 0302 Officers on space available basis.
- b. Current documented Expert rifle qualification.
- c. Full duty status and 20/20 corrected vision. No existing or recurring medical problems and no history of mental problems or disorders.
- d. Twenty-four months remaining on contract and/or deploying on next unit
- e. No existing family or financial problems that would preclude the Marine from completing the course.
- f. Must meet current height and weight standards.

3. Course Nominations, Funding, Lodging & Messing.

- a. Course seats will be provided by WTBn Quantico. POC is Mr. Bob Bayer, C476 Sponsor (Marksmanship/Precision Marksman Sponsor), S-3 Operations, WTBn Quantico, at robert.w.bayer@usmc.mil or (703) 784-6682. Nominations will be sent via the unit S-3 chain of command to Division G-3 Training Sections. Division will prioritize and compile nominations to Mr. Bayer; SOIs and FMTUs will send directly to Mr. Bayer. All attendees will be registered in MCTIMS, course identification (CID) M02RG79.
- b. For class 2025020 only, Cross Org LOA funding will be provided via confirmation email, class 2025030 and 2025040 are unit funded. Class 2025020 only, students will create a new DTS document TDY trip. Under "Accounting" in the DTS document select "Add LOA" then select "25 WTBN". This will also auto populate the DTS request routing list "QUAN WTBNRL", please do not change this or we will not be able to approve the DTS authorization.
 - c. Government lodging (no cost) directed and will be provided.

d. Rental cars or in/around mileage will not be authorized. Rental cars are the parent commands responsibility and unit accounting data must be provided in DTS for rental vehicles. DTS submissions with rental vehicles on WTBn Cross Org LOA funding will be denied.

4. Travel & Check-in.

- a. Students will check-in on the course report date. Ronald Reagan Washington National Airport (DCA) is recommended for inbound flights. Highly recommend arrival no later than early afternoon to facilitate check-in and proper rest. Students are responsible for travel arrangements to and from the schoolhouse. Please check-in with the WTBn OOD (WTBn HQ, Bldg #27211) in appropriate civilian attire. Physical address to WTBn is 27211 Garand Road, Quantico, VA, 22134. Student MCC K49, RUC 30903
- b. Return travel flights must not depart earlier than 2100 on the graduation date. This will allow appropriate time for travel to the airport after graduation. The last day of the course is a live fire evaluation day and weapons maintenance, early release will not be authorized.
- c. All students must be seated in the IMT classroom (Bldg #27200) by 0700 on the course convene date. Enter through side door annotated on map chip of this document. Bring original orders, signed command screening checklist, copy of BIR/BTR, copy of flight/travel itinerary, note taking gear, PPE, range gear, and hydration container. Uniform throughout the course and graduation is MARPAT's.
